



**SITE 1- GERALD REGNITTER-
WOODWORKER, and CAROL HOFFERD-
STAINED GLASS ARTIST** Friendly Forest
Products- 411 Hwy #2 (3.6 km. north of Hwy
263 junction)

SITE 2-URSULA BRONS -PAINTER
At the Hwy. 2/Hwy.263 junction turn east onto
the grid road, go 5km. Turn north (the first
road after the Beaton road). Go 2km. to the
end of the road.

SITE 3- TOM LAXDAL-KNIFE MAKER
10 km down Hwy. 953 to McPhail Cove, Emma
Lake, one km into McPhail Cove to Block 1, Lot
12

SITE 4- SHARON MILLER - PAINTER
From Hwy. 263, turn north onto Hwy 953. Turn
left onto Ambrose Drive. At the stop sign just
after Ambrose Store, turn right towards the
lake. At the Y, go left along Lakeshore Drive to
cabin #125. It is the second cabin on the left
hand side.

MULTI FACETED ARTISTS and LORETTA
RATTI-BROST -GLASS WORKS**
At Sunnyside Beach, go down Southshore drive
to 5th Street. Turn toward the beach and go the
the Pink Cabin at #21

SITE 6- DOROTHY MACPHEDRAN- POTTER
Form and Fire- From Hwy. 263 to Hwy 952 to
Carwin Park- 201 Carwin Park Drive, Emma Lake.

SITE 7- GAIL CARLSON- POTTER- From Hwy.
263, 4km down Hwy. 952, turn right into
MacIntosh Point, Emma Lake, first left, third
cabin down.

SITE 8 -JEROME MRAZEK-PAINTER-
On Hwy 952, go to Murray point. Turn
onto Victoria Ave. turn left at Kaldor
Ave. and right at Jarvis St. to 301.

**SITE 9- JASON LEO BANTLE-
PHOTOGRAPHER** All in the Wild
Gallery- 18 km west on Hwy. 263 from
the Hwy.2/Hwy263 junction, next door to
the Prince Albert National Park gate.
